

Policy 2121 – Superintendent’s Contract

The Board of Education shall have the power to employ a legally certified Superintendent of Schools for one year, but no contract shall be offered exceeding three years. The Superintendent shall be appointed by the Executive Officer of the Board and have such powers and duties as may be prescribed by rules adopted by the Board and by law. It shall be the Superintendent's duty to make recommendations to the Board concerning the educational policies of the Board and regulation for the government of the school.
