

Policy 2221 – Discipline, Suspension and Expulsion

The Principals shall report all cases of excessive absence, tardiness, truancy, unusual cases of discipline, and disregard for school rules, regulations and policies to the Superintendent. The Principal may suspend a pupil for just cause. Notice being given in writing immediately to the President of the Board of Education and the Superintendent. The right to expel a pupil from school is reserved by the Board of Education upon recommendation of the Superintendent.
