

Policy 5116.1: Permission for Pupils to Leave School Premises

No pupil shall leave the premises during school hours without permission of the Principal granted upon written request of parents or guardian, or for good cause known to the Principal. Telephone requests for excuse of pupils from school shall be referred to the Principal and honored with caution.

Supplement to Policy 5116.1: Student Release during School Hours

Students will be allowed to leave the school district facilities during school hours only with prior authorization from their parents. Unless the parent appears personally at the student's attendance center to arrange for the release of the student during school hours, or with the permission of the principal, or authorized state agency representative.

Approved reasons for release of a student during the school day shall include, but not be limited to, [illness, family emergencies, medical appointments, classes outside the student's attendance center, employment for which the student has been issued a work permit] and other reasons determined appropriate by the principal.
